
Let's Talk Math 7 Honors

Math 7 Honors requires pre-algebra skills in order to be successful


Math 7 Honors students take the Math 8 SOL test



 - Most classes are held with other middle school students, but some classes could be with high school students


ELECTIVE Classes - SEMESTER LONG
