Our goal at Lake Braddock is to help each student reach their potential. For class selection, we encourage students to enroll in the most rigorous course in which they can be successful. We want our students to benefit from the rigor of our curriculum while experiencing a sense of accomplishment.

Parents/guardians are an important component of the decision-making process when it comes to identifying the best class for their child. We ask that parents discuss the options with their child and the child's teacher to determine which course will challenge their mind and at the same time maximize their learning. Please also consider the number of honors courses your child can handle based upon their current academic progress, as well as time commitments outside of school, when making core selections.

Criteria to consider when determining whether an honors class is appropriate for your child:

English Honors: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enjoys reading and does so on a regular basis without prompting. • Enjoys writing and composes in paragraphs using correct grammar. • Scored at least a 430 on the last reading SOL and reads above grade level. 	History Honors: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enjoys and is intellectually curious about history. • Reading and writing above grade level. • Able to make connections between the content and their life.
Science Honors: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enjoys science and grasps scientific concepts quickly. • Possesses analytical skills. • Self-driven, motivated and inquisitive. • Ability to make connections between the content and their life. 	Math 7 Honors = PreAlgebra (Math 8): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed the Math 7 Curriculum in Advanced Math during 6th grade. • Tries to solve math problems independently. • Strong Math students who did not take Advanced Math are encouraged to take Math 7 and then progress to Algebra in 8th grade.

Please consider, when you are making selections for classes next year, that you are committing to those courses for the entire school year. Parents/guardians will receive a course verification listing in May, and any requests for change must be received by LBMS Student Services no later than June 7th. Please note: **placement in remediation/support classes is based on student achievement data and takes priority over elective choices.**
