Needs Assessment


- All students completed a Needs Assessment during the Counselor Introduction Lesson

- Data is used as a starting point for determining counseling groups


School is a happy/positive place for me.


When I have a problem, I feel comfortable talking to an adult at home.


When I have a problem, I feel comfortable talking to an adult at school.


Bullying and Harassment Lessons

I have witnessed someone being bullied and/or I have been bullied before.



At this time, I am comfortable intervening (telling bully to stop, reporting to an adult) when I see someone being bullied .



SOS Wellness Screening

- All 7th grade students were screened for signs of depression and suicidal thoughts through Advisory classes.

 Of the 745 students screened, 51 students indicated that they were at high risk for suicide and of those, 7 students were taken into immediate care.
