# STUDENT PEACE AWARDS OF FAIRFAX COUNTY- Nominate Yourself or a Friend!

One student (or group of students) from each high school is eligible to receive a Student Peace Award of Fairfax County. The award consists of \$250 for the recipient personally plus \$100 to be donated to the student's choice of a nonprofit whose principles are consistent with the goals of the Student Peace Awards. A certificate will also be presented at the annual awards ceremony. The award can be given to either a **junior or a senior** (or to a club/organization that includes at least one junior or senior). Students are only eligible for the award once in their high school career. The selected students and their families and friends will be invited to a reception on Sunday, March 13, 2022.

*Guidelines for the award:* The recipient should have worked specifically for peace or to identify and resolve conflicts (as opposed to participating in charitable or social activities or simply believing in peace).

#### Examples of items to be considered in selecting a nominee:

- Demonstrates commitment to peace by engaging in activities that strive to end conflict, either locally or globally.
- Seeks to discuss or otherwise resolve controversial issues within the school or community to bring about positive resolutions to those issues.
- Promotes the understanding of divisive issues and situations to bridge language, ethnic, racial, religious, gender, sexual orientation, or class differences.
- Works to resolve conflicts among students or members of the community who feel isolated or alienated.
- Advocates for awareness of humanity's place in the ecosystem and responsibility for stewardship of the earth.
