NOVA Early online College

<u>NOVA Early Online College (EOC)</u> allows current high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to take up to 2 tuition free college courses. <u>EOC courses</u> for the Spring semester begin on January 30, 2024, and end on April 22, 2024. Registration opened on October 23rd. Deadline to register is January 8, 2024 at 5pm. Courses are asynchronous, online, and for college credit only. 13 different courses are offered along with courses that fulfill the <u>IT Technical Support Career</u> <u>Studies Certificate</u>. EOC courses are selected because they meet the requirements for most of NOVA's Associate degrees as well as being highly transferable as general education requirements for most colleges and universities. <u>NOVA Site - Early Online College Information</u>

Receive Benefits Through the SAT Fee Waiver Request Form

Starting in late Fall 2023, students will be able to access the SAT Fee Waiver Request Form through the main fee waiver webpage, <u>sat.org/feewaivers</u>. After submitting responses to a few questions on a form, students may receive approval for fee waiver benefits by email within a few days. College Board may reach out to adult contacts that the student provides to confirm their fee waiver eligibility. Once approved, students will see their fee waiver benefits loaded into their account.

The festival is dedicated to connecting high school students and their families to HBCUs, and scholarship opportunities.
