The event will take place at the Fairfax Courthouse (4110 Chain Bridge Road, Fairfax, VA 22030) on **Saturday, March 16**, from **9:30 AM to 2:00 PM**. We are also hosting an <u>optional</u> essay contest; entry into the essay contest is not required for

the participation in the Color of Justice Program but, if a student participates in the essay contest, they are eligible to win a prize. I have attached a registration packet with more information on the event to this email.
