During Session 1, applicants will complete the Direct Enrollment Survey, record their results to use with advising and view their program of study. They will learn how to check holds, Financial Aid checklists and who to contact for resolution and assistance (if applicable, forms will be provided to clear any holds, i.e.: under 18, dual enrollment form, in-state tuition, etc.)

During Session 2, applicants will review their program of study, first semester's recommended courses, learn how to access the registration system via SIS and how to select and register for classes.

Students should attend one of each session.
