JumpStart2NOVA - Summer 2024 Opportunity for Graduating Seniors

JumpStart2NOVA is available this summer for qualified seniors graduating this spring and considering NOVA for the Fall. Students may select one 3- or 4-credit approved course plus SDV 100: College Success Skills, at *no tuition*!

- The application for JumpStart2NOVA is now open and closes at 5pm on Friday, May 10, 2024.
- Courses begin on Monday, June 3, and end on Monday, August 12.
- All classes will be offered asynchronously through NOVA Online.
- Courses are tuition free.
- Students are responsible for purchasing textbooks or other course materials, if required.
- Courses have been selected based on their usability in NOVA degrees and their status as part of the Uniform Certificate of General Studies.

First time NOVA students will need to apply to NOVA and create an account to request the course in nvcc.dualenroll.com. Current DE students can skip the NOVA application and go straight to nvcc.dualenroll.com, selecting term "JumpStart2NOVA 2024." All students will be required to upload their current high school transcript and qualifying test scores.
