NOVA is pleased to announce <u>JumpStart2NOVA</u> for summer 2022. Please note there are a few changes to this award-winning program targeting seniors who are thinking of attending NOVA in the fall. The application is open now and a press release from NOVA is coming very soon.

Who/What: Qualified seniors graduating this spring may take one 3-credit course and our 1-credit College Success Skills course, SDV 100, at no tuition.

When/How: All classes will be offered through NOVA Online and run May 31<sup>st</sup> through August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Students are required to pay for textbooks or other course materials.

The application is now open and will close at 5PM on April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022. First-time NOVA students will need to apply to NOVA and create an account to request the course in nvcc.dualenroll.com. Current DE students can skip the NOVA application and go straight to nvcc.dualenroll.com, selecting term "JumpStart Summer 2022." All students will be required to upload a high school/homeschool transcript and any qualifying test scores if they do not have a 3.0 GPA.
