This site, in addition to our Online Course Catalog, Rising 7th Grade Curriculum Night and counselor programs, will be used to help all our students and families identify courses for the upcoming school year. Academic Advising

The first opportunity to learn more about Lake Braddock and course selection will be at the Rising 7th Grade Curriculum Night on January 13th from 6:30-8:15 pm. Middle school counselors will also present to rising 7th grade students to provide introductory information about Lake Braddock and course offerings - either in-person at the elementary school or virtually for smaller feeder schools. Course selection sheets will be provided to each student for course discussion with parents.

Later in January, elementary school counselors will meet with students to enter courses online in SIS and review the courses they selected. Course selection sheets will be collected by the elementary counselor at that time. Parents will be able to view the courses students have entered after academic advising using their ParentVue account. <u>CLICK HERE</u> if you need help accessing your ParentVue account.
