Outstanding Teacher: To be eligible for nomination a teacher must:

• Have completed at least three full years of teaching, regardless of location

Outstanding New Teacher: To be eligible for nomination a new teacher must:

• Be within the first 3 years of their teaching career, regardless of location

Outstanding Principal: To be eligible for nomination a principal must:

- Currently work as an elementary, middle, secondary or high school principal in FCPS
 - o Assistant or Associate principals are not eligible for this particular award consider nominating them for Outstanding Leader
- Have begun their fourth year as a building principal (experience in an acting capacity is not counted)

Outstanding New Principal: To be eligible for nomination a new principal must:

• Be within the first 3 years of their assignment as building principal (in any school/district)

Outstanding Leader (School-Based)

- Assistant Principal
- Director of Student Services
- Director of Student Activities

To be eligible for nomination, a School-Based Leader must:

• Currently work as a full-time or part-time Schedule C employee or School-Based Administrator <u>who has</u> <u>completed at least one contracted year of employment working with FCPS in their current position at their current</u> <u>work location</u>.

To be eligible for nomination, a School-Based Professional Employee must:

 Currently work as a Schedule-B employee in an FCPS school or center, or in a non-instructional position that supports school leadership and <u>has completed at least one contracted year of employment working with FCPS in</u> their current position at their current work location.

Outstanding Operational Employee (School-Based)

To be eligible for nomination, a School-Based Operational Employee must:

• Currently work as a Schedule-A, Schedule-H, or Classroom Instructional Support (CIS) employee <u>who has</u> <u>completed at least one contracted year of employment working with FCPS in their current position at their current</u> <u>work location, or an hourly employee who has been working regularly in one position for more than one year</u>.
