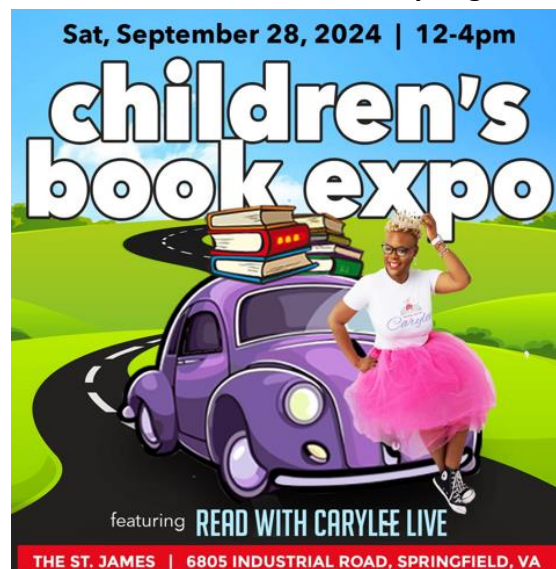

Food for Others is an important part of Northern Virginia's food insecurity safety net, serving over 3,000 families and 3,900 children a week through the Power Pack Program, which provides weekend meals to roughly 3,800 students at 44 Fairfax County schools during the school year. The weekend meal pack helps alleviate a child's hunger and allows them to come to school on Monday morning fed, focused, and ready to learn.

- **Fairfax County's Farmers Markets** have raised the amount of **matching dollars for fruits and vegetables up to \$40 per week** this season. Families who qualify can get these double SNAP funds when they shop with their EBT card at the markets. See the flyer for locations and details.

SNAP AT FAIRFAX COUNTY PARK AUTHORITY FARMERS MARKETS

Use your SNAP benefits at select Farmers Markets and get up to \$40 dollars of additional fruits and vegetables for FREE. Come to the SNAP information tent to swipe your EBT card in exchange for tokens. Use your tokens like cash, but only at the Market at which they were purchased. Tokens never expire.
