-The health department has introduced extended hours next week and in November at various clinics, specifically tailored for school-age children to catch up on their essential, school-required immunizations.

-The Fairfax County Health Department offers maternal child health home visiting services through: Nurse-Family Partnership® and Maternal Child Health Field Nurse programs. Services are provided by experienced Public Health Nurses for low-income, high-risk pregnant and postpartum women, infants, and children. The Public Health Nurses provide comprehensive, multifaceted care to clients, targeting a multitude of stressors such as low socioeconomic status, history of trauma or abuse, and mental health conditions in order to promote positive health outcomes.

You can fill out and return the <u>Maternal Child and Family Support Home Visiting Programs Referral</u> Form to have a staff member contact you about home visiting services.


ENGLISH CLASSES
