The goal of the [Health and Biomedical Sciences Summer Program](#) is to provide a window into the scientific basis of human health. Through lectures and **hands-on laboratory investigations** in state-of-the-art laboratories, students will be introduced to the fundamentals of disciplines such as molecular biology, neuroscience, physiology, pharmacology, immunology, and other medical sciences. In addition, students will interact with practicing professionals in fields such as medicine, physical therapy, toxicology, nursing and biomedical laboratory research.
