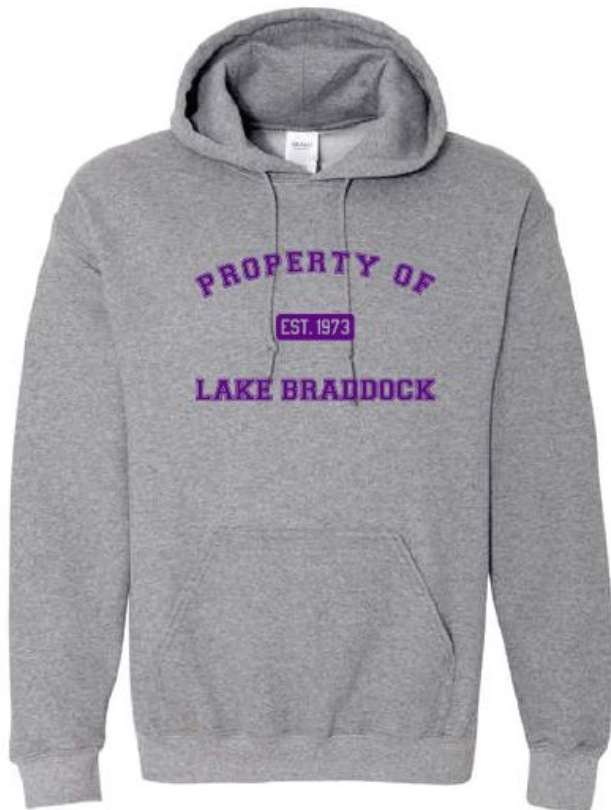

Bridging Bruins

Bridging Bruins is a high quality work based learning internship program that seniors have the opportunity to participate in at the end of the year.

This program provides students with the opportunity to end their school year early and begin working as an intern to explore future career paths and gain valuable experience in a work environment of their choice.

Bridging Bruins Interns will be excused from their final exams and school work (except AP exams, Dual Enrollment finals and a couple other specific cases).

Interns must successfully complete 45 internship hours during the window, complete check-ins, write a reflection paper, and create a presentation of learning.

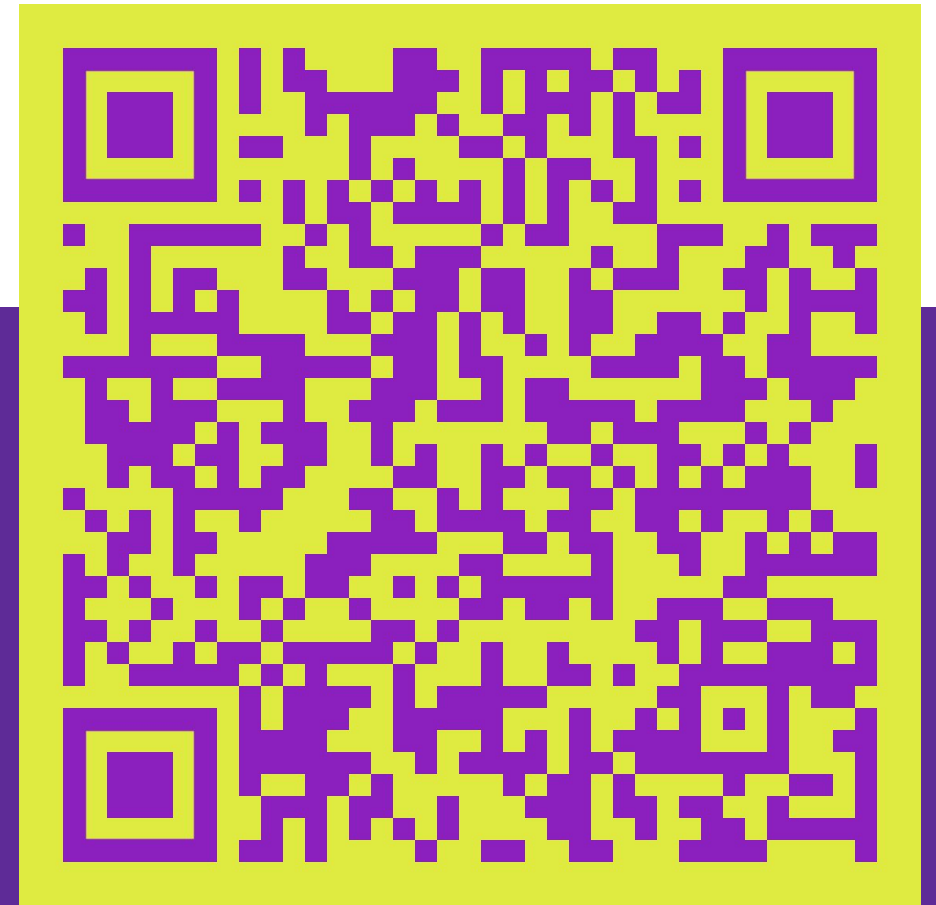

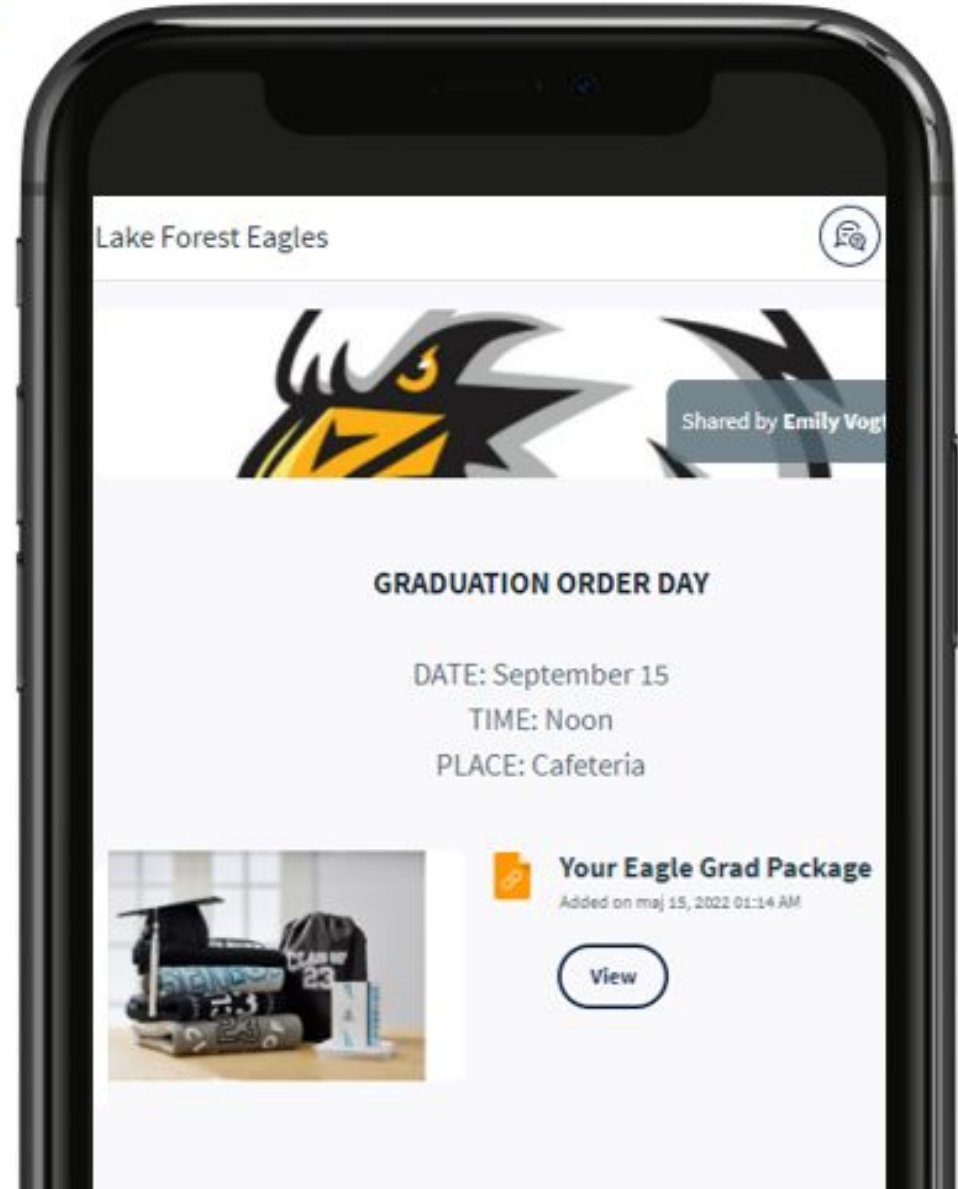
