




Backwards Mapping Plan

Backwards lapping

- Break down the larger task into smaller components
- Decide length of time and resources needed for each component
 - Set mini deadlines
- Record their mapped out plan
- Revisit plan and deadlines throughout the completion process
- Edit plan/deadlines as needed
