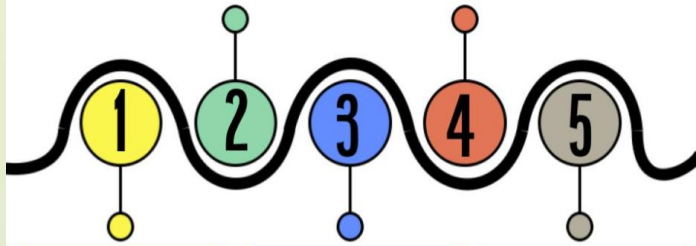

Backwards Mapping Plan

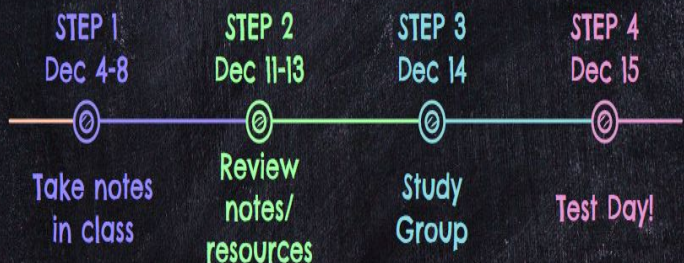

Backwards Mapping

When assigned a major task (project, essay, test, assessment) students should...

- Break down the larger task into smaller components
- Decide length of time and resources needed for each component
- Set mini deadlines
- Record their mapped out plan
- Revisit plan and deadlines throughout the completion process
- Edit plan/deadlines as needed
