

What Supports Does a SAPS Provide?

WHEN SHOULD I CONTACT THE SUBSCHOOL?

Absences

• Please call the attendance line in the event of an absence by **9:35am** to avoid the automated call outs. Students can also bring a note to their Subschool upon return to excuse absences.

Late Check-In

• Student should report to the security podium to check in, and bring a parent note to their Subschool, if they have a reason for an excused tardy. They will then be provided with a late pass to class.

Early Check-Out

- Students must check out of subschool office when leaving school early.
- Middle school students must have a parent come in the building to check them out.

WHEN YOUR CHILD IS OUT SICK

- Call the attendance line
- Check Schoology for homework assignments
- Email teacher(s) if you have questions
- Students have as many class days missed to make up and turn in work

*Remind your child to go see their teachers as soon as they return to school to submit missing assignments and schedule a time to make up any tests/quizzes.

ADVISORY and WIN TIME

What is it?

Advisory is time to connect with a staff member and other students in a smaller setting. Social Emotional Learning (SEL) is conducted through Advisory. WIN time is for students to receive additional help from a teacher or counselor.

When is it?

Advisory and WIN are held during 2nd period. The block is broken into 2 parts. All students stay together during Advisory. Students may flex out to work with teachers they have pre-arranged to meet with during WIN time.

GRADING

- Letter grades will be used in place of 4, 3, 2, 1
- Homework cannot count for more than 10% of a student's grade
- All teachers will have a retake/second chance assessment policy
- Report Cards will be carried home with students at the end of each quarter
- Progress Reports will be emailed weekly automatically through SIS
- Teachers are required to email a detailed progress report at interim and final grade time
- SIS ParentVue / SIS StudentVue can be used to see detailed progress at any time

eHall Pass

- -All student movement in the building during class hours will be monitored using e-Hall Pass.
- Students can request passes to see teachers and teachers can request passes to see students.
- Bathroom trips require e-Hall Pass and the class lanyard.
- -Passes from teachers, counselors, or other staff will not count against a students allotted daily pass requests (4)

LOCKERS

Students may OPT-IN to receive a locker; it will not be automatically assigned

- Additional information on opting in will be provided in August
- Backpacks are allowed in all classes
- Students have **7** minutes to transition between classes
- Be cautious when bringing in valuables such as (cell phones, tablets, laptops, headphones, etc)
- the safe-keeping of items are your student's responsibility
- Do not share the combination with ANYONE
- Keep it locked!
- Inside of lockers can be decorated

- Each student has a confidential PIN number



- After School: Middle School Students need a pass from a teacher


HEALTH ROOM

TECHNOLOGY

SIS ParentVue

Parents will receive a letter over the summer with information on how to access/activate their account

Important to activate prior to the beginning of school

SIS will be live on day one, but grades may not be available until the end of September

TECHNOLOGY

One-to-One

All students will be assigned a laptop for use at school and home

Schoology Account

Parents must have an active SIS Parent Account to be able to log into Schoology The same login will be used to access both SIS and Schoology

Electronics Policy

Phones must be silenced and put away during all instructional periods. Phones can be stored in a locker or backpack during the day. Students are prohibited from using phones, tablets, and other mobile devices in restrooms and locker rooms, unless there is a medical necessity or emergency. Teachers may allow usage of cell phones for instructional activities when appropriate. Cell phones may be used on campus before the first bell, after the last bell, during passing periods, and lunches.




